The Sustainable Eel Group is looking for consultancy, contract or other part-time support during 2023 to assist in its programme to complete the journey to ISEAL Code Compliance



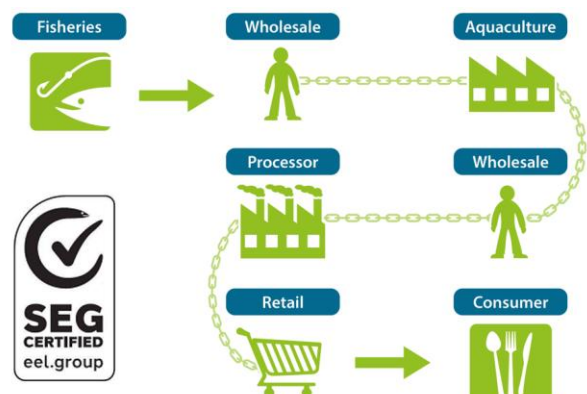
Overview
